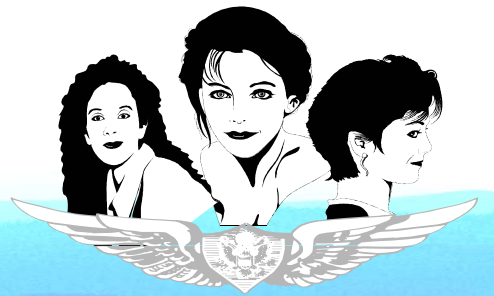


# AirScoop

Linda was an aviation enthusiast, she had to overcome many obstacles, both personal and health related, to become a pilot. In life, she was active in encouraging others to pursue their passion for flying, and now the San Gabriel Valley 99's wish to carry on her legacy by awarding this scholarship to another woman who wishes to fly.

The Linda Hayden Memorial Future Woman Pilot Scholarship is a perpetual scholarship awarded to a resident of the San Gabriel Valley and surrounding areas who meets the following criteria:

- Female
- Not a licensed pilot
- A United States Citizen
- **Between the ages of 17 and 30 as of March 1, 2008**

The Linda Hayden Memorial Future Woman Pilot Scholarship is a \$750 award in the form of a check presented to the scholarship recipient, payable to a certified flight training school of their choice. Scholarship funds not used within 12 months of award will be forfeit.
